## Charity Spotlight—Madi's House

Madi's House offers support and activities for young adults who struggle with addiction and mental illness. We are a free, non-residential community center that provides fun, recreational activities and emotional support like music, games, art classes, wellness programs, and special events to foster ongoing wellness. Madi's House is the only one of its kind in the region.

With the levels of substance abuse, suicide and untreated mental illness growing at epidemic rates in the Tri-State, Madi's House unique approach fills a need that health professionals say is imperative, right now. For nearly a half million people in our area, when struggling with addiction and mental illness, the current system is broken. Money is spent on short-term crisis recovery but very little is spent to prevent relapse, or in transitioning back into everyday life. There is a vicious cycle of illness, treatment, and relapse with no long-term solution, especially when transitioning back into everyday life. Madi's House breaks that cycle.

Madi's House fills an unmet need by providing a welcoming, non-judgmental, upbeat, and enjoyable place to simply hang out! We give young adults battling addiction and mental illness a place of support and a true sense of belonging and community. We provide the important missing piece after outpatient treatment. We are your solution to empty free time.

As the first and only relapse prevention and mental health community day center in Cincinnati, Madi's House, "The Annex," officially opened to the general public on November 27, 2020. As the first phase of the overall plan for Madi's House, we are located in a large, 2,200 square-foot space on the west side of Cincinnati.
